Font Times New Roman 12 pt, aligned text, spacing 1.5 pt, paragraph indentation 1.25 cm, no additional spacing between paragraphs, margins: top and bottom - 2.5 cm, right and left - 3 cm. Page numbers at the bottom, centred. All indexes - automatic. Footnotes - reference in the text usually before punctuation marks, footnote content: Times New Roman 10 pt font, spacing 1.0 pt.

The introduction should include:

- justification for the choice of the topic (why it is worth investigating the given issue and what the conducted research will contribute to the existing state of knowledge),
- purpose of the thesis,
- theses, hypotheses or research questions (optional for bachelor's theses, obligatory for master's theses),
- scope of the study and the period covered by the study,
- description of the thesis structure (how many chapters there are and what each of them is about),
- indication of the research methods applied and characteristics of the sources used in the thesis.

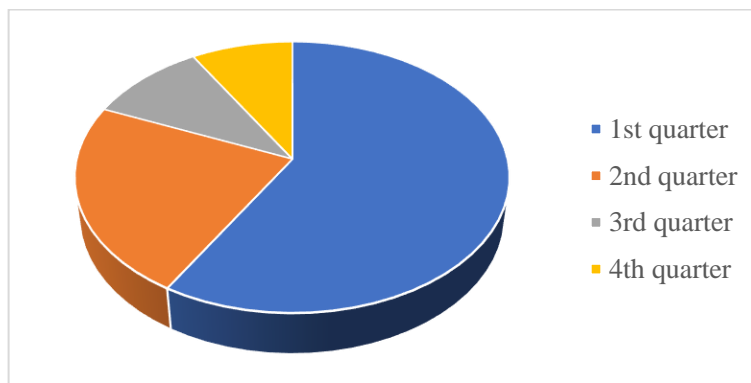


Figure 1. Title of the figure
